



Coding Cards for Automatic Dialers

Details are covered in the BSPs. The following summarizes info in several BSP issues.

Instructions for cards in Figs. 5 and 6.

1. Write name and number on card
2. Under each digit, punch the perforated circle in both the top and bottom groups. Two punches per digit.

For example, to code a 5 punch the circles in the 456 and 2580 rows.

3. A punch in the STOP row causes the dialer to stop before dialing the digit in that column. In Fig. 6, the punch in the digit 3 column causes the dialer to stop
